Public Workshop:

Planning Manager Baraconi presented the two maps from Cowlitz-Wahkiakum Council of Government (CWCOG) reflecting the slopes within the area, one with the Wegmann Study overlay.

She also presented the current code and the proposed code showing what types of studies are required at different slope percentages.

The goal is to show where building is permissible without a report, where a geological reconnaissance study is needed, where a Geotech report is required, or if building is not permitted in a certain area.
