

**TOPIC OF DISCUSSION: Goal Setting**



Mayor Futcher displayed on the overhead the 2010 Goals that were discussed at a workshop in August of 2010. He opened the discussion by asking Councilmembers what changes or additions they would like to make. Several changes were made to the list, each followed by a brief discussion. Councilmembers voted on each topic to see which goals the majority wanted to pursue during the next year. Lengthy discussion followed.
