MOTION: Jerry made the motion, seconded by Dan to approve the minutes of January 16, 2014. Motion carried, all in favor.

Business:

1. South Kelso Neighborhood Association – Fishing Park Preliminary Proposal – Wallace Hall

They would like to convert the City property along the river at the end of Mill Street into a fishing park, complete with covered fishing stands, seating, and handicap access. A draft illustration was provided for review. The cost as well as the labor would be carried by donations.

Scott mentioned that this is only the beginning of the process, as there are several approval and permitting steps that must be completed prior to construction. He also suggested that the handicap accessible stand be moved closest to the parking area. Discussion followed.

Jerry made a motion to recommend the association move forward with the proposal, Dan seconded. Motion carried, all in favor.



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2. Proposed Changes to Park Fees – Nina Caulfield

We have worked to clarify the park fees to make it easier to compute the fees. Several categories of users were taken out or consolidated into others, as well as the removal of the \$0.005 charge per square feet of use.

Jerry made a motion to recommend to Council the changes to the park fees, seconded by Dan. Motion carried, all in favor.

3. Parks Updates – Tim Mackin

The Leagues are gearing up for their seasons.

Little League is starting with their renovations.

The CDID2 Pump station at the back of Tam O'Shanter Park was recently reroofed. The CDID2 supervisor has requested some of the trees that are dead/dying/damaged near the pump station be removed to prevent damage to the roof. Scott was curious if we have a tree replacement program/requirement. Tim responded that there is none. Discussion followed.

Jerry made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Dan seconded. Motion carried, all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 6:37 pm.
